1. Festival Hours

The festival runs from 12:00 PM to 6:00 PM. A parking map can be found on our website. Please plan your arrival and departure accordingly.

2. Admission

Admission is free for all attendees. However, donations are welcome and appreciated to support the event and its future editions.

3. Re-Entry

Re-entry is allowed. Those 21+ will receive a wristband to access the beer garden. Please retain your festival wristband or hand stamp for re-entry.

4. Service Animals Only

While we love dogs, only certified service animals are permitted on the festival grounds. This policy is in place to ensure the safety and comfort of all attendees.

5. Seating and Shade Structures

To ensure everyone has a clear view of the stage and performances, we ask that attendees with shade structures set them up in the back area of the festival grounds. Please be considerate of others when choosing your seating location.

 Tent Restrictions Please note that no tent stakes or poles are allowed to go into the Town Green. While small beach shade canopies are accepted, pop-up tents are not allowed, except for vendors and exhibitors who have prior approval and necessary permits.

7. Prohibited Items

The following items are not permitted on festival grounds:

- Weapons of any kind
- o Fireworks or explosives
- Illegal substances
- o Bicycles, scooters, or skateboards within the festival area
- Unauthorized vendors or solicitations

8. Alcohol Consumption

Alcohol is only permitted in designated areas. Please drink responsibly and ensure that those under the age of 21 are not served or provided with alcoholic beverages.

9. **Smoking** As this is a family-friendly event, we ask that smoking of any kind occur away from festival grounds.

10. Litter and Recycling

Help us keep the Windsor Town Green clean! Please dispose of trash in designated bins and utilize recycling containers where available.

11. Lost and Found

A lost and found station will be located at the festival information booth. Unclaimed items
